Introduction

Programme "Greening Economies in the Eastern Neighbourhood of European Union (EaP GREEN)" aims to support participating countries in their transition to a "green economy" and boost the "green business". Participants of the program are six countries of Eastern Neighbourhood of European Union: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.

The programme is being funded by the European Commission (EC) and other donor-countries and is implemented by the joint action of United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO).

One of the components of EaP GREEN programme is the demonstration project for realization and expansion of Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP) - common concept of UNEP and UNIDO, which foresees the introduction of preventive environmental strategy regarding production processes to enhance production efficiency and reduce risks to humans and the environment.

Forum target

Forum "Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP): energy efficiency" is the first of series of six thematic forums that will cover topical issues of sustainable consumption and production, energy efficiency, material and water efficiency, reduction of emissions, waste management, reduction of the volume and clearance of wastewater.

The aim of the forum is to promote and expand RECP among the wide range of interested parties, in particular among the representatives of small and medium-sized businesses, NGOs, science and education, government agencies and others.

This format of the event includes the presentational part, where will be discussed the topical questions of the energy issues in industry and ways and opportunities of energy efficiency rising

The participants of the forum "Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP): energy efficiency" will be invited to share experiences and views and discuss energy efficiency issues and ways of its improvement. The event also foresees the performances of the participants about their own experiences in relation to energy efficiency increase. Also it is planned to make a short survey of various interested parties to assess the social opinion about the problems of efficient consumption of energy at the industrial enterprises of Ukraine. The results will be analyzed and used to formulate future tasks of RECP.

Participation in forums will contribute to familiarization with the methods and practices of RECP and their understanding and will facilitate its adaptation in Ukraine.
